How We Assist the Mondavi Center



SCHOOL OUTREACH

Friends select regional school districts and some specified school programs to receive free tickets to a Mondavi Center school matinee. These students may not otherwise have an opportunity to attend a performance at Mondavi Center. Funds for these tickets are raised at Friends' events.

PRE-MATINEE CLASSROOM TALKS

Friends present 30-minute docent talks in classrooms at area schools to prepare students who are attending a Mondavi Center school matinee. Docents use materials researched and written by Friends.

SCHOOL MATINEE USHERS

Friends volunteer as ticket takers and ushers for all Mondavi Center school matinees. Each year, Friends will welcome more than 10,000 students to the UC Davis campus through the School Matinee Series.

MONDAVI CENTER TOURS

Since Mondavi Center's 2002–2003 inaugural year, Friends have managed and staffed the public tours at the Mondavi Center. Approximately 1,000 people are expected to participate in Mondavi Center Tours this season. Over the summer, Friends provide tours to parents of incoming students during UC Davis summer advising weeks.



GIFT SHOP

Friends manage and staff the gift shop in the southeast corner of the Yocha Dehe Grand Lobby. Through annual gift shop proceeds, Friends help support the Mondavi Center Arts Education Program.

FRIENDS EVENTS

The Friends Events Committee plans and hosts a variety of hospitality occasions for the Friends throughout the year. Some events raise funds for the Joyce Donaldson School Matinee Program and provide opportunities for Friends to socialize with other Mondavi Center supporters who share common interests.

THE SPOTLIGHT

This informal program puts the spotlight on a selected performing arts topic. This event supports the Friends' traditional focus on adult education and offers another opportunity for Friends to socialize.

ARTIST RESIDENCY ACTIVITIES

Friends may drive visiting artists to their school residency activities, introduce them to the participants, and report to Mondavi Center staff on the students' responses to the artists.

AD HOC SUPPORT

Friends assist Mondavi Center staff by helping with mailings and day-of-event duties.

MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

This committee plans and implements events to welcome new and prospective members into Friends. Informal gatherings are held throughout the season providing the opportunity to build connections within the organization and Mondavi Center.
